**ORDER**

1. The allegation in this letter, which has been treated as an application, is that the stone crushers at village Tilora, Rausa, Tehsil Mehar, Zilla Satna at NH-7 (New Fourlane) are creating dust pollution. They are located within 5 to 10 metres of the National Highway as against the requirement of 500 meters. The haze created by the operation of the stone crushers results in road accidents. It also impacts the health of the inhabitants of the area.
2. In view of above, we direct a Joint Committee of representatives of Central Pollution Control Board, State Pollution Control Board and the District Magistrate, Satna may forthwith look into the allegation and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
3. The State Pollution Control Board will be the Nodal agency for executing this order.
4. Needless to say that order of National Green Tribunal is binding as a decree of Court and non-compliance is actionable by way of punitive action including prosecution, in terms of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.
